Applications are invited for a post-doctoral researcher to join Dr Steven Pollard and Prof Austin Smith FRS, to study the molecular mechanisms of self-renewal and differentiation in human neural stem cells and brain cancer stem cells. You will have a PhD and practical experience in the fields of molecular developmental biology, stem cell biology or cancer research.

The post will be paid on the University's Pay scale as Grade 7 £25,134- £32,796. This position is part of a Cancer Research UK funded project grant and has a fixed tenure of 30 months.
